

Azorean canning Industry and PL fishery jeopardized




Why and how



Pole and Line (1998-...)

9 observers team until 2018 (reduced to 5)

> 3500 Fisheries Observer Reports

>20.000 DAYS AT SEA (aprox. 30.000 fishing events)

Surface longline (2008,2010, 2015-...)

2 to 3 observers

> 80 Fisheries Observer Reports

> 1800 DAYS AT SEA (aprox 1000 hauls)


Bottom longline (2010, 2017-2019)

2 observers

> 70 Fisheries Observer Reports

> 500 DAYS AT SEA (aprox 300 hauls)

- Technology and fishing operation
- Target species, by-catch, discards, associated species (eg: cetaceans, sea birds, seaturtles)
- Marine debris; Abiotic data (SST)





What was achived

Scientific information (eg)

- . Estimating common dolphin bycatch in the pole-and-line tuna fishery in the Azores (2018)
- . Distribution and composition of floating macro litter off the Azores archipelago and Madeira (2019)
- . An overview of fisheries discards in the Azores (2019)
- . Relative abundance of oceanic juvenile loggerhead sea turtles in relation to nest production at source rookeries (2019)






On-line geolocated databases that gather global spacial information on animal groups tuna, cetaceans, birds, turtles
