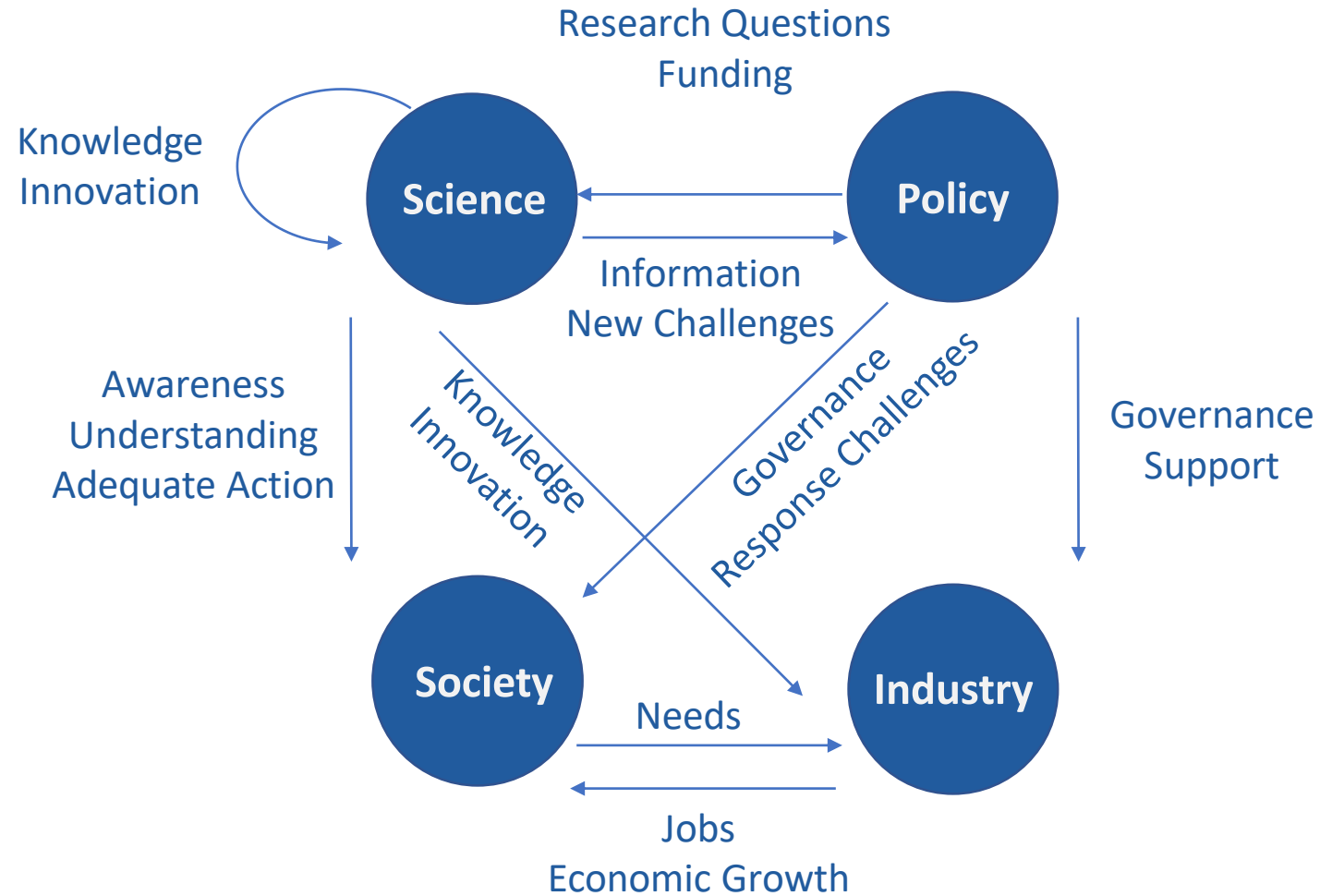
# What is Knowledge Transfer?

The sharing or dissemination of knowledge, skills, methodologies, technologies and competences between relevant actors for collective benefit.

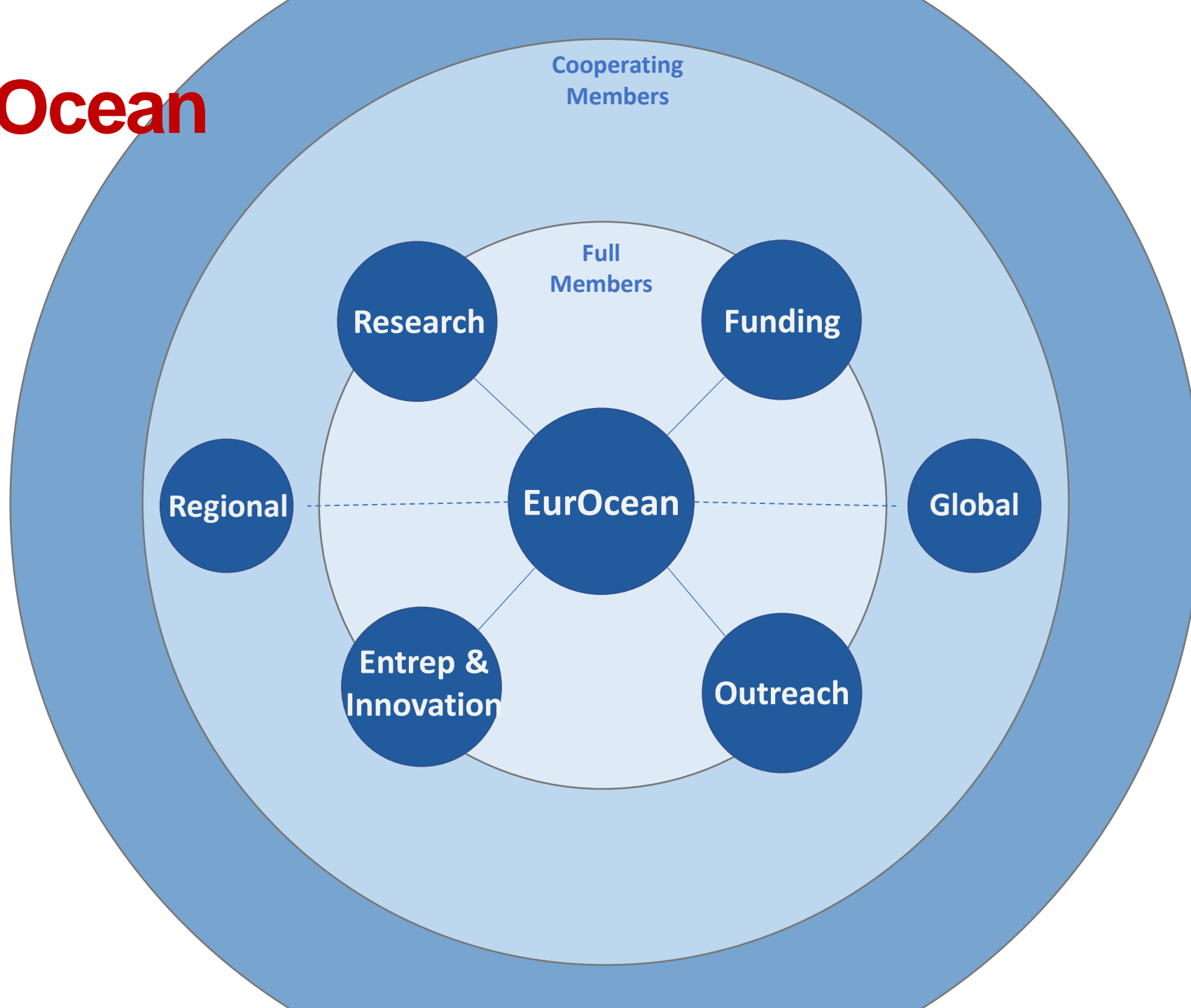
Knowledge transfer:

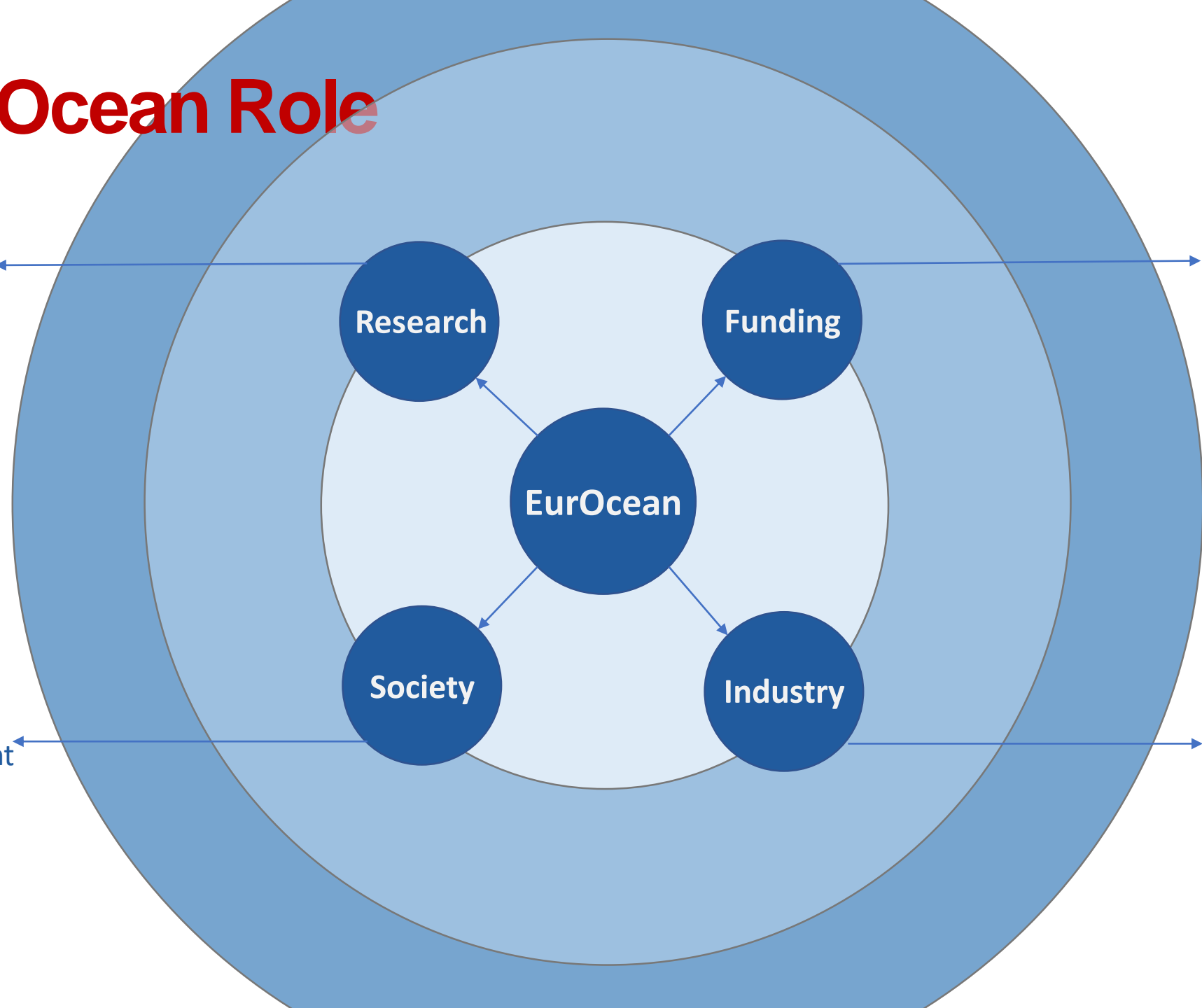

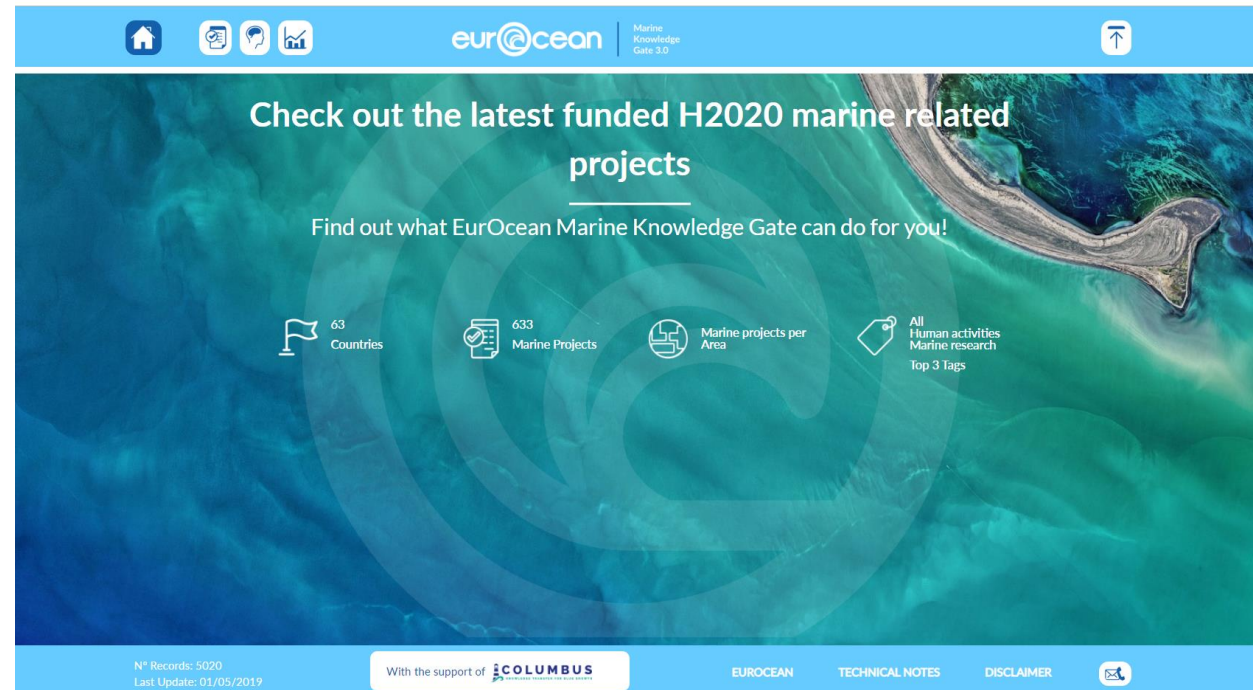
